



# Edible Image<sup>®</sup> Print-Ons<sup>®</sup> Template Instructions

## 2" Round Circles\*

- Determine which size resolution your graphic / photo file is and select the template file to download that matches your image resolution. Options include:
  - 72 Resolution – for lower image quality
  - 120 Resolution – for middle quality
  - 300 Resolution – for higher quality
- Save the template file you require onto your computer.
- Open the template file in your photo manipulation program.
- Open your image/photograph file in your computer's photo manipulation program.
- Size your image to approximately 2.15" x 2.15"
- Change the canvas size to 8.5" x 11"
- Select "All" on the template file
- Copy the template file
- Paste the template file into the image/photograph file. You will notice that this creates a "matte" for the photos.
- Go to the layer with the image/photograph file in it and move the image/photograph to be centered within one of the circles.
- Once you have the image cropped as you desire:
  1. Select the area of the now cropped photograph that is within the circle.
  2. Copy this selection.
  3. Paste this selection
  4. Move the selection to another circle.
- Repeat steps 1-4 above until all circles are filled and you are ready to print.
- Print your images.

## **3” Round Circles\***

- Determine which size resolution your graphic / photo file is and select the template file to download that matches your image resolution. Options include:
  - 72 Resolution – for lower image quality
  - 120 Resolution – for middle quality
  - 300 Resolution – for higher quality
- Save the template file you require onto your computer.
- Open the template file in your photo manipulation program.
- Open your image/photograph file in your computer’s photo manipulation program.
- Size your image to approximately 3.15” x 3.15”
- Change the canvas size to 8.5” x 11”
- Select “All” on the template file
- Copy the template file
- Paste the template file into the image/photograph file. You will notice that this creates a “matte” for the photos.
- Go to the layer with the image/photograph file in it and move the image/photograph to be centered within one of the circles.
- Once you have the image cropped as you desire:
  5. Select the area of the now cropped photograph that is within the circle.
  6. Copy this selection.
  7. Paste this selection
  8. Move the selection to another circle.
- Repeat steps 1-4 above until all circles are filled and you are ready to print.
- Print your images.

## **Business Cards\***

- Determine which size resolution your graphic / photo file is and select the template file to download that matches your image resolution. Options include:
  - 72 Resolution – for lower image quality
  - 120 Resolution – for middle quality
  - 300 Resolution – for higher quality
- Save the template file you require onto your computer.
- Open the template file in your photo manipulation program.
- Open your image/photograph file in your computer's photo manipulation program.
- Size your image to approximately 3.35" x 1.75"
- Change the canvas size to 8.5" x 11"
- Select "All" on the template file
- Copy the template file
- Paste the template file into the image/photograph file. You will notice that this creates a "matte" for the photos.
- Go to the layer with the image/photograph file in it and move the image/photograph to be centered within one of the rectangles.
- Once you have the image cropped as you desire:
  9. Select the area of the now cropped photograph that is within the rectangle.
  10. Copy this selection.
  11. Paste this selection
  12. Move the selection to another rectangle.
- Repeat steps 1-4 above until all rectangles are filled and you are ready to print.
- Print your images.

## **7.5” Round Circle\***

- Determine which size resolution your graphic / photo file is and select the template file to download that matches your image resolution. Options include:
  - 72 Resolution – for lower image quality
  - 120 Resolution – for middle quality
  - 300 Resolution – for higher quality
- Save the template file you require onto your computer.
- Open the template file in your photo manipulation program.
- Open your image/photograph file in your computer’s photo manipulation program.
- Size your image to at least 7.5” in both height and width (height or width may be larger than 7.5”)
- Change the canvas size to 8.5” x 11”
- Select “All” on the template file
- Copy the template file
- Paste the template file into the image/photograph file. You will notice that this creates a “matte” for the photos.
- Go to the layer with the image/photograph file in it and move the image/photograph to be centered within the circle.
- Print your image.
